



Notification of the Ministry of Education
on
Reopening of Educational Institutions

With reference to the Notification of the Ministry of Education on the Closure of Educational Institutions Affiliated with and under the Supervision of the Ministry of Education on 17 March B.E. 2563 (2020), stating that all public and private educational institutions both formal and informal education were to be closed under the State of Emergency from 18 March B.E. 2563 (2020) onwards until further notice.

By virtue of the provisions of Section 9 in the first clause (4), the regulation of the Ministry of Education on the Academic Year: Closure and Opening of Educational Institutions B.E. 2549 (2006) and the second amendment B.E. 2558 (2015), all public and private educational institutions, both formal and informal education, affiliated with and under the supervision of the Ministry of Education shall be reopened on 1 July B.E. 2563 (2020). Such educational institutions shall offer teaching and learning provisions in accordance with the State of Emergency over Covid-19.

Furthermore, international private schools with different school term dates are permitted to start the school semester immediately, providing that they are able to offer instructional models and methodologies in line with the State of Emergency as declared in the area where each school is located.
